We know what you need to be taught and to learn and we know how to prepare you for the next stage in your journey. We know what you know and what you don't know so we can support every child to flourish. We know when you need adaptations to support your learning (Equity). We know your individual needs (targets / IEPs / next steps / attainment). We know if you have additional needs and how we can support you. We know that the needs of our children are changing and we will change their journey with the same high expectations. We know what sports / clubs / hobbies you do and what you excel at. We know what our community needs and what is important to them. <p>Pupils said "the adults in school..."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> know what we like and dislike. know where we live and who our families are. know our personalities. know who our friends are. know when we're feeling sad. ask questions about us. know our voice. know how to look after us. listen to our 'show and tell' if we bring something in. remember things we have told you and you ask us about it again. do 'all about me' activities at the start of the year. Every person is made in the image of God and is a unique gift. Everyone is loved so we will enable you to 'live life in all its fullness' (John 10:10) All our children will flourish in the love of God, living the most fulfilled life. We love every child so it matters to us that you fulfil your full potential both in and out of school. Because we love our children, we will ensure our curriculum is broad, balanced, progressive and enables all children to achieve and thrive. Our Reception children will be provided with the best start in life. We want to provide our children with many rich opportunities and experiences to they become well rounded individuals. We love every child so building relationships and getting to know every child is key to them feeling loved and as though they belong to our school family. Everyone will be given the same opportunities. Adaptations will be made where required so that everyone can access the same opportunities. Our behaviour and relationships policy is built on belonging. Our children will feel they belong to the 'Reepham Family'. Our children will be part of our 'Reepham Traditions' such as trips, productions, experiences, gatherings, church services etc. Our children will know the 'Reepham Way' – our school values and how to be good citizens. Our children will wear their Reepham uniform with pride and know they belong to our special School Family.
