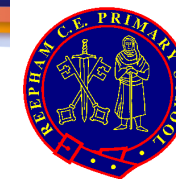



What can I do today to show love to other people?</p>	<p>Key Bible verse: 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 - Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not selfseeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Colossians 3:14 (CEV): 'Love is more important than anything else. It's what ties everything completely together.'</p>

Because of this, they don't talk to nor trust each other. But this Samaritan stopped and helped. He didn't care that the dying man was a Jew. Instead, he only saw a fellow human being who needed help. This is what makes the Good Samaritan Parable one of the greatest Bible stories about loving others. It tells us that love has no race or borders. If someone is in need and we are in a position to extend help, we should. Someone's belief, skin colour, or religion shouldn't matter because we all belong to the same race – the human race.</p>
