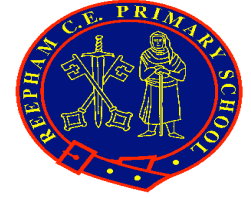


Updated Snow Procedures

Any children that do not want to go in the snow will be given the option of staying inside.

Snow Closure

While we don't anticipate closing, we know some of our pupils travel a distance to get here, if you are concerned about drop off or collection due to adverse changes in weather, please let us know and if the weather is an agreed barrier, it will not affect pupils attendance data.

Please also understand that if the school does stay open, there may be times when clubs are cancelled, usual lessons don't happen or different staff are required to take a class.
